The revision would be brought forth for Board approval at the next regular meeting. The Board discussed proposed amendments to the bylaws regarding attendance requirements and quorum concerns.

Chair Byrd provided a historical overview of the Sustainability Action Plan draft. Ms. Barnett offered an overview of plan draft efforts to date. The Board discussed the need for additional meetings to accomplish tasks to completion.
